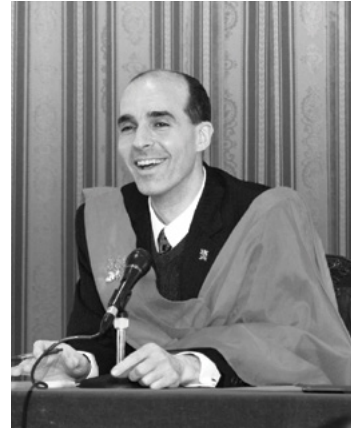

Your Checklist for a Successful Rally 2026

Please do not feel overwhelmed by your rally preparations. It doesn't have to be complicated. Trust in Our Lady knowing that you are changing lives and helping lead America toward a more holy future!

To use this checklist, follow timelines on the dark tabs and check off steps as you go.

Take notes at the bottom as needed. Save for future rallies!

Left sidebars include additional helpful information.

Build a team and assign tasks

Ask friends/family/parishioners to volunteer to help with:

- Invite list – gather names with email/text/mail addresses
- Invitations – mail, hand out at church, email or text (see pg. 9 and 10) and track RSVPs
- Prayer program – assign prayer readers and make copies to bring to your rally
- Know that everyone can follow the prayer program with our new mobile phone version (see pg. 17)
- Banners/posters – be sure they are assembled and ready (see pg. 7)
- Photographs – assign someone to take a group photo day of rally
- Rally set up/clean up

ASAP TASKS

- Review this checklist and make your rally game plan
- Ask friends, family, or parishioners to help with your rally
- Fully open and inspect banner for damage; save the storage tube
- Select a visible, public location for your rally
- Create your invite list (friends, family, parish groups, schools, etc.)
- Mail/email/text rally invitations (see pages 9-10)
- Confirm how you will display your banner at the rally (see pg. 7)

OPTIONAL TASKS

- Email rally invitation to your church for use in the September 19, 26, and October 3 bulletins
- Post rally details on your church's website and calendar
- Encourage more people to join your team

TIME TO HOLD YOUR OCTOBER RALLY!

Displaying Your Banner:

- Option 1: Use Velcro to attach each short end to 5-ft. PVC poles (see instructions that came with banner).
- Option 2: Add grommets and tie to poles, a wall, or table.
- Option 3: Tape gently to a surface (avoid damage).
- Do not cut or use strong adhesives.
- Save the mailing tube to store your banner for next year.

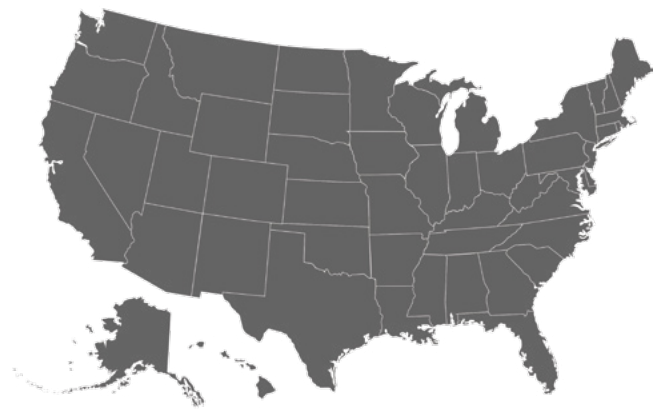

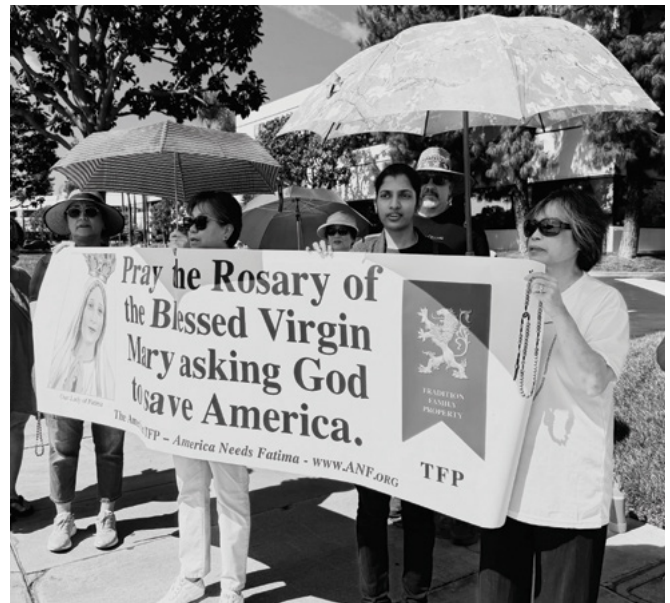

Share to Inspire Future Public Square Rosary Crusade Captains!



- **Your rosary rally will honor the Miracle of the Sun**, a very public event performed near Fatima by Our Lady and witnessed by 70,000 people, including atheists, communists and anti-Catholics.
- **You will reach fallen away Catholics** of which there are an estimated 20 – 40 million in the United States. If they see you praying in a public place, they may be moved to become better Catholics.
- **You will introduce others to the Catholic faith** and the Fatima message to pray the rosary for peace. In this way, you are following the apostles, whom Our Lord sent forth to teach all nations. Rally captains have reported conversations with non-Catholics about the rosary, the Blessed Mary, and prayer in general.



- **Your public rosary rally will be an act of reparation** for sins hurled against the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
- **You will make a difference.** Consider the relentless efforts of pro-life Catholics who have peacefully prayed the rosary in front of abortion clinics for decades. The power of their prayer has blunted the advance of abortion.
- **Your rosary rally can save America!** Consider what has happened in other countries: In Vienna, Austria, at the end of World War II, Fr. Petrus Pavlicek led massive public rosary processions which prompted Communist troops (invaders) to pack up and leave.
- **Your rally will fulfill our duty to honor God publicly and will prepare us for Our Lady's triumph over evil.**

Public Square Rosary Rally

On October 13, 1917, Our Lady performed the Miracle of the Sun, witnessed by 70,000 people at Fatima, including atheists, communists and anti-Catholics (leading many to convert).

To honor this miracle, which occurred around noontime, and to show Our Lady we hear her request to stop offending God by our sins, we are hosting a public rosary rally SATURDAY, OCTOBER 10 at NOON.

We know our sins have caused America to suffer a societal collapse – and we know we must urgently stop sinning if we hope to enjoy God’s blessings and to avert His wrath. He will hear us, if we pray through the intercession of His Blessed Mother.

In *The Secret of the Rosary*, Saint Louis de Montfort said: “Public prayer is far more powerful than private prayer to appease the anger of God and call down His mercy, and Holy Mother Church, guided by the Holy Ghost, has always advocated public prayer in times of public tragedy and suffering.”

7. **Read Remaining Optional Prayers and Litanies as Time Allows**
8. **Closing:** Thank you for praying with us today and for sharing our devotion to the Blessed Mary with our community.
9. **Sign of the Cross:** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Intentions

Please read any or all of the following intentions. Add your own or replace them as needed.

- To show God and His Blessed Mother our love and veneration, we offer this rosary rally as a special public commemoration of Our Lady's apparitions at Fatima.
- Through the Most Holy Rosary, we ask Our Lord and Our Lady for the conversion of America so that it may fulfill its historic mission.
- For an end to "Black Masses," pornography, same-sex "marriage," and all other offenses against God.
- For the protection of those who speak out against sins and offenses committed daily against the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Most Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- That our national leaders would seek to honor God's law.
- For the urgent triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary in America and the world.
- For the Catholic Church, may Our Lady grant it victory over its enemies, declared and undeclared.
- For America Needs Fatima, may Our Lady grant her many graces for increased dedication and efficiency in her service to the Church.
- For an end to abortion in all 50 states.
- For the generous benefactors who made these rallies possible.
- For the dying, may Our Lady hasten to comfort them in their last moments and grant them the final graces necessary for the salvation of their souls.
- For each one of us, may Our Lady give us discernment and strength to withstand the trials we face.

In group prayer, "V" stands for "versiculus" (said by the leader) and "R" stands for "responsum" (said by the group). Follow this format when praying aloud together.

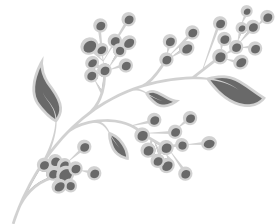

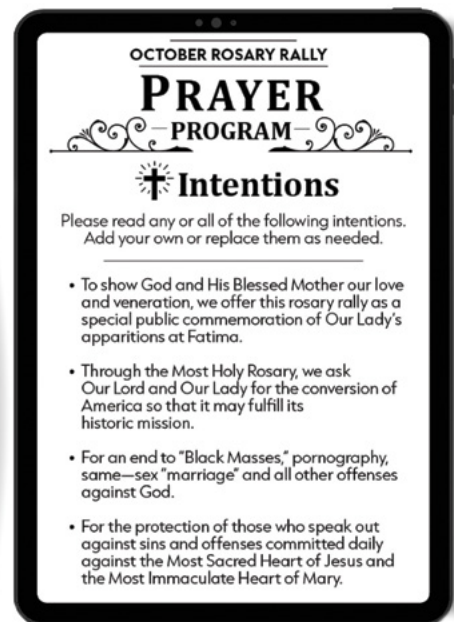

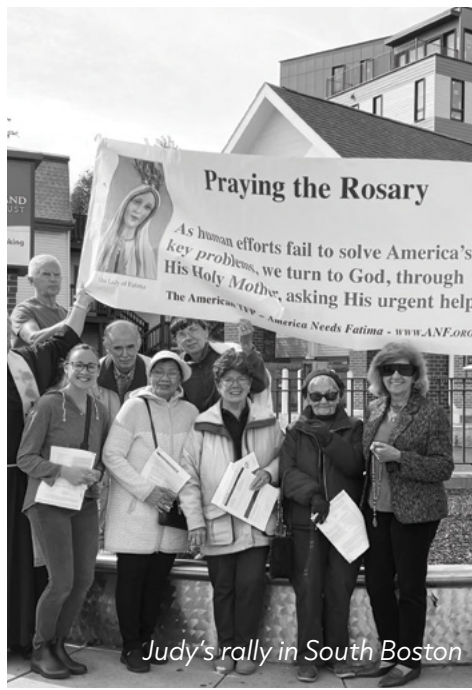

The story of Fatima

A Brief History of Our Lady of Fatima and the Public Miracle of the Sun:

The First Visit - May 13, 1917

Around noon, Lucia dos Santos, age 10, and her cousins, Francisco and Jacinta Marto, ages 9 and 7, saw "A lady, clothed in white, brighter than the sun." The Lady smiled and said: "Do not be afraid, I will not harm you ... I come from heaven. Are you willing to offer yourselves to God and bear all the sufferings He wills to send you as an act of reparation for the conversion of sinners?" After Lucia said yes, the Lady said, "Say the rosary every day to bring peace to the world and the end of the war."

The Second Visit - June 13, 1917

The children returned to Cova at noon and saw a flash of light followed immediately by the apparition of the Blessed Mary. She spoke to Lucia: "I want you to come on the 13th of next month, to pray the rosary every day, and to learn to read. Later, I will tell you what I want." She opened her hands and radiated an immense light. In her right hand she held her Immaculate Heart encircled with thorns.

The Third Visit - July 13, 1917

The three children assembled at the Cova at noon and again saw Our Lady who told them to "Continue to pray the rosary every day in honor of Our Lady of the Rosary in order to obtain peace for the world and the

end of the war, because only she can help you." She promised she would tell them who she was in October, and would perform a miracle for all to see and believe.

The Fourth Visit

The children could not witness the fourth apparition as they were kidnapped by the mayor of Vila Nova de Ourem. Despite his threats of death, they would not lie about the apparitions. He finally released them on August 15. The Virgin Mary did appear to the children on August 19 and told them to continue to say the rosary every day, and again promised a miracle in October.

The Fifth Visit - September 13, 1917

Around noon, Mary appeared again to the children and spoke to Lucia: "Continue to pray the rosary in order to obtain the end of the war. In October Our Lord will come, as well as Our Lady of Sorrows and Our Lady of Mount Carmel. St. Joseph will appear with the Child Jesus to bless the world. God is pleased with your sacrifices."

The Sixth Visit - October 13, 1917

Again around noon, the children reached the Cova da Iria where tens

of thousands of pilgrims had gathered, despite the rain. There was a flash of light as the Blessed Mary appeared before the children and told Lucia, "I am the Lady of the Rosary. Continue always to pray the rosary every day."

Lucia said, "After Our Lady had disappeared into the immense distance of the firmament, we (the children) beheld St. Joseph with the Child Jesus and Our Lady robed in white with a blue mantle, beside the sun. St. Joseph and the Child Jesus seemed to bless the world, for they traced the Sign of the Cross with their hands. When, a little later, this apparition disappeared, I saw Our Lord and Our Lady."

The 70,000 pilgrims witnessed the public "Miracle of the Sun" when the sun whirled and zig-zagged, casting colors about the crowd as it began to descend toward the earth. The crowd cried out in terror, thinking it was the end of the world. After about 10 minutes, the sun returned to the sky. Then a howling wind began to blow, despite the leaves on the trees remaining still. The rain-soaked people were suddenly dry and their clothes clean, and the ground was completely dry.
